



Finding Information on Anatomy & Physiology in the JSCC Library

Books:

Use the JSCC online library catalog to find books. The catalog is available from the JSCC Library home page at <http://library.jsc.edu>. Search by subject, author, title or keyword.

Books in the JSCC Library are arranged according to the Library of Congress Classification System. Each book is assigned a unique call number. Books written about the same subject have similar call numbers, grouping them together on the shelves and making it easy for you to browse. For books on your topic, check the shelves for call numbers beginning with...

Periodicals and Databases:

These databases/electronic indexes are available from the library home page <http://library.jsc.edu> click *Databases*, then select the database you wish to search. Please ask us for the usernames and/or passwords you'll need to access these from home.

- *Health & Wellness Resource Center* - Encyclopedias, directories, a medical dictionary, and many full-text magazine, journal, and newspaper articles, all dealing with topics in health, medicine, medications and wellness.
- *Nursing & Allied Health Comprehensive* - Designed for nursing and allied health professionals, students, educators and researchers, this database provides full text for nearly 400 journals covering the areas of nursing, biomedicine, health sciences, consumer health and allied health disciplines. Nearly all full text titles included in Nursing & Allied Health Comprehensive are indexed in CINAHL.
- *CINAHL*- Cumulative Index to Nursing and Allied Health Literature. An index for over 1200 professional journals in nursing and 17 allied health disciplines. In addition, CINAHL offers access to healthcare books, nursing dissertations, selected conference proceedings, standards of practice, educational software in nursing, audiovisuals, and book chapters.

- *Health Reference Center Academic* - Integrates the full text and images of respected nursing, allied health and medical journals; consumer health magazines; newsletters; pamphlets; newspaper articles; topical overviews; and reference books. Includes 40 full-text nursing and allied health journals plus the wide variety of personal health information sources.
- *General Science Full Text* - Easy-to-use and designed specifically for students and non-specialists, General Science Full Text is the first place to look for answers to science-related questions.
